## Art Clay Silver Leaves

Graceful and amazing – leaves from your own garden can be used to create these lovely pendants. Using very few materials, we'll make one or more pendants during this class. You'll learn how to use Art Clay Paste effectively and fire your pieces with a torch. Given enough time, we'll even get these pendants into the tumbler for a high polished shine!

### Supplies Required:

20gm Art Clay Silver Paste: 480153

Wire for bail or connectors

Approx Supplies Cost: \$50



### Supplies Recommended:

Art Clay Silver Clay Syringe w/1 tip:480154

Fire-in-place stones, ask about approved list

Paint brushes: 316205

Clay/Wax working metal tools: 321253 – be sure it includes a spatula type tool
