

Veberod Gem Gallery Class Notes

Basics of Soldering Gold

Many of the techniques learned in soldering silver transfer well to working in gold, but it is a different alloy and has some different properties. This class will highlight those differences as you gain confidence soldering while making a gold ring.



Supplies Required:

3 inches 14KT Gold Wire
14KT gold solder EZ

Tools Required:

Boric Acid
Denatured Alcohol

Basic tools and supplies required for most classes:

Jeweler's sawframe: 349704	Polishing points: 310446, 310448, 311466
Clamp on benchpin: 313361	Center punch: 347900
Chain nose pliers: 346518 or 346160	Bur wax: 319928
Wire cutters: 346122 or 346209	White diamond polishing compound: 347448
Drill bits: 328565 or 328500	Rouge compound: 347416

A note on cost of supplies - Our classes are not kits, we try to encourage creativity. It is difficult to give even an estimate for the cost of supplies since most people have some items already, and most classes have different options. If you have never taken classes before and need everything, we will be happy to let you use whatever tools we have available for your first class so you can discover how enjoyable it can be! The one-time cost for the basic tools and supplies required for all classes after that is about \$60. In addition each class has a list of required tools and supplies. For this class that cost will run about \$100.
