## Byzantine Bracelet



With nothing more than 2 pair of pliers and some jump rings, we'll make this gorgeous bracelet in just an afternoon! Wonderfully complex looking but so easy once you get started this chain is always a favorite. Be prepared to make these for all of your friends, everyone always wants one!

### Supplies Required:

4.76 ID, 16ga Sterling Jump Rings, approx 120pcs:  
481374, 481375

1 Heavy Clasp

### Tools Required:

2 pr. Chain Nose – or – 1 pr. Chain Nose and 1 pr. Flat Nose Pliers

\* Recommended : German Chain Nose Pliers: item # 346140

### Tools Recommended:

Rock Tumbler and Stainless Steel Mixed Shot

Liver of Sulphur if desired

Recommended Book: Great Wire Jewelry

### Basic tools and supplies required for most classes:

Jeweler's sawframe: 349704

Clamp on benchpin: 313361

Chain nose pliers: 346518 or 346160

Wire cutters: 346122 or 346209

Drill bits: 328565 or 328500

Polishing points: 310446, 310448, 311466

Center punch: 347900

Bur wax: 319928

White diamond polishing compound: 347448

Rouge compound: 347416
