

# Veberod Gem Gallery Class Notes

## Square Wire Pendant

This is a more advanced wire working class with a pre-requisite requirement- completion of Veberod's Linking class, the Wire Cage Pendant class OR experience working with half-hard wire. In this class we will create a pendant with a 30 x 40 calibrated oval cabochon, learning techniques that you will be able to adapt to create custom wire bezels for cabochons of all shapes as well as many tumbled or rough specimens. We will cover design elements and choosing stones to wrap. This is an art that requires patience and precision, but is essentially easy to learn. With practice, you will develop a distinctive style of wrapping that is all your own!

30x40mm Oval Cabochon  
22ga Half Hard, Square Wire - Copper, Silver or Gold-Filled: 486036, 480505, 482505

Scotch Tape
