Square Wire Ring

NEW! Your friends won't believe that you can make this intricate ring out of nothing but wire and a small cabochon. Prove them wrong! With practice, this ring is fairly simple to make and the combinations of metals and stones you can use are endless. (I)



Supplies Required:

18x13mm Oval Cabochon

3'ft 22ga Sterling or Gold-Filled Half Hard, Square Wire

2ft 21GA Sterling or Gold-Filled Half Hard, Half-Round Wire
