

# Veberod Gem Gallery Class Notes

## Woven & Riveted Silver Cuff

Few project samples have earned the attention that this one has! Learn how to make a beautiful woven cuff in this one day class. No heat required! All techniques learned in this class are “cold” techniques. We’ll cut and weave our sheet then frame it and rivet the ends on.



### Supplies Required:

28ga Sterling Sheet, 4x6”

26ga Sterling Sheet, 2x6”

16ga Copper, Brass or Sterling Wire

### Tools Required:

Bench Shears: 353800 or 353804

Riveting Hammer: 337209

#55 Drill Bit: 328555

Bench Block: 312317 or 312319

Parallel Jaw Pliers, Flatnose w/Teeth: 346506

Decorative Stamps

Masking Tape

### Basic tools and supplies required for most classes:

Jeweler’s sawframe: 349704

Clamp on benchpin: 313361

Chain nose pliers: 346518 or 346160

Wire cutters: 346122 or 346209

Drill bits: 328565 or 328500

Polishing points: 310446, 310448, 311466

Center punch: 347900

Bur wax: 319928

White diamond polishing compound: 347448

Rouge compound: 347416

**A note on cost of supplies** - Our classes are not kits, we try to encourage creativity. It is difficult to give even an estimate for the cost of supplies since most people have some items already, and most classes have different options. If you have never taken classes before and need everything, we will be happy to let you use whatever tools we have available for your first class so you can discover how enjoyable it can be! The one-time cost for the basic tools and supplies required for all classes after that is about \$60. In addition each class has a list of required tools and supplies.
